In interaction with the Church and its importance for the Passion Play in Oberammergau, a concentrated place of reflection and contemplation is created:

Three of the last seven words of Jesus on the cross are projected into the interior of the parish church as a moving immersive light installation.

„Father, forgive them because they don't know what they are doing“

„My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?“

„Father, into your hands I commend my spirit“

Detlef Hartung and Georg Trenz have been working on complex, site-specific, light-text installations both nationally and internationally since 1998. They realize many of their works in Church rooms, examples of which include the monastery church in Fürstenfeldbruck (2013, 2015), the Freising Cathedral (2015, 2018) or the south facade of the Cologne Cathedral (2018).
